

#### ★★★★★ €uroStars – How to interpret them

- Each star represents where the animal ranks on each index in 20% bounds
- One star represents the bottom 20% of the breed for that trait
- Five star represents the top 20% of the breed for that trait
- The higher the stars, the higher the predicted profitability of that animal



Animals that only have the outline of a star represent animals that have within flock evaluations, this means the star rating of these animals cannot be compared to any other animals from a different flock.


#### Rank

- This figure indicates more precisely where the animals rank within the breed. eg. Top 16% (see example below)
- This is displayed with a shaded line, the further to the right these are on the scale, the better its
  position within the breed.

#### Acc% (Accuracy%)

- This figure is very important as it represents the amount of data behind each evaluation. Where Acc% is low, much less emphasis should be placed on the evaluation, and vice versa.
- Accuracy is displayed for the Replacement & Terminal Indices. It is not displayed for the four sub-traits. If an animal has high accuracy on Replacement & Terminal, it will be high accuracy across all traits.

#### **Ancestry Information**



- 1) Replacement (€3.44) If a farmer desires a ram to breed both lambs both for slaughter and replacement ewe lambs then they should select a ram based on this index. The bulk of this index is a combination of Lamb Survivability, Days to Slaughter, No. of lambs born & Daughters milk. The € value beside the index represents the difference in profit that each lamb sired from this ram will have. This € value is an across breed value, so different breeds can be compared to each other.
- 2) Terminal (€2.86) If a farmer desires a ram to breed only lambs for slaughter then they should select a ram based on this index. The bulk of this index is a combination of Lamb Survivability and Days to Slaughter. The € value beside the index represents the difference in profit that each lamb sired from this ram will have. This € value is an across breed value, so different breeds can be compared to each other.
- 3) Lamb Survivability This ranks animals based on lambing ease and lamb survival rate. Every positive % point on this index is an extra lamb surviving to 40 days and vice versa.
- 4) Days to Slaughter This ranks animals on their genetic ability to grow. The index associated with this trait represents the difference in the predicted number of days required for the progeny of this ram to reach the desired slaughtered weight compared with other animals of the same breed.



- 5) No. of Lambs Born This ranks animals based on the predicted prolificacy of the females from this animal compared with other animals of the same breed.
- **6) Daughters Milk** This ranks animals based on the predicted milking performance of their daughters compared with other animals of the same breed.

### RAM FERTILITY GUARANTEE

### 1 MALE FERTILITY GUARANTEE

1.1 All rams and ram lambs sold at a Society sale are warranted by the seller to be capable of natural and effective service up to 30th November of the year of the sale of the Sale ("the Male Guarantee Period") provided always that:
1.1.1 any animal which is not so capable and where the incapacity is caused or contributed to by injury or illness

howsoever caused, suffered or contracted after the sale is not covered by the warranty; and

- 1.1.2 any animal which has not been conclusively determined as incapable of natural and effective service in accordance with the procedure set out hereinafter and which dies of natural causes during the Male Guarantee Period is not covered by the warranty.
- 1.2 An animal shall be deemed incapable of natural and effective service if:
  - **1.2.1** It fails to make at least one ewe pregnant during the Male Guarantee Period under natural breeding conditions and
  - 1.2.2 it is certified as being so incapable by a veterinary surgeon in accordance with clauses 1.4 and 1.5 below. "Natural breeding conditions" means when a ram is run with ewes in normal breeding condition, cycling without artificial interference. Ewes which have been sponged and/or treated with hormones to induce or synchronise ovulation are deemed not to be in normal breeding condition.
- **1.3** The buyer shall throughout the Male Guarantee Period give the animal full and sufficient opportunity to prove that he is capable of natural and effective service and maintain him in a fit condition.
- 1.4 If the buyer highlights that the ram or ram lamb has failed to prove capable of natural and effective service by 2 calendar months from sale date of the year of sale, the buyer shall then:
  - 1.4.1 Notify the seller and the Society in writing that the animal is to be tested; and
  - 1.4.2 Have the animal subjected to a semen test by the artificial vagina method by a veterinary surgeon attached to a breeding company authorised by the Society; and
  - 1.4.3 Obtain from the veterinary surgeon a duly completed Soundness for Breeding report; and
  - 1.4.4 If the veterinary surgeon certifies that the animal is incapable of natural and effective service, lodge a copy of the Report with the seller and the Society.
- 1.5 The seller shall be entitled to:
  - 1.5.1 Have a second test carried out by the same or a different veterinary surgeon attached to a breeding company authorised by the Society who shall issue a Soundness for Breeding report after notification by the purchaser and such Report shall conclusively determine whether or not the animal is capable of natural and effective service. The seller shall deliver to the buyer and the Society a copy of this second Report: or
  - 1.5.2 Arrange to take possession of the ram or ram lamb for up to two calendar months from the date of the duly completed Soundness for Breeding Report provided by the Buyer to determine whether or not the animal is capable of natural and effective service. If the ram or ram lamb makes at least one ewe pregnant during the Male Guarantee Period the seller will lodge a copy of any scanning report with the buyer and the Society. If the buyer disputes this report the matter will be referred to the Committee. The Society reserves the right to extend these periods to facilitate scanning of ewes to determine pregnancy and/or taking samples to carry out parentage tests. Any fees or charges in relation to parentage tests will be paid by the buyer.
- 1.6 The decision of the Committee shall be final and binding on all parties to the dispute and has the power to ensure that the decision is implemented.
- 1.7 The buyer shall at the expense of the seller do all acts, deeds and things necessary to enable the second test to be carried out. If the animal shall be deemed fertile the buyer shall on demand repay the seller the veterinary surgeon fees of the second test and Report.
- 1.8 If the ram is deemed incapable of natural and effective service the buyer may by 30th November of the year of the Sale return the animal to the seller and thereupon the seller shall repay to the buyer the whole of the purchase price and the cost of transport of the animal from the buyer's premises to the seller's premises and the veterinary surgeon testing fees incurred by the buyer.
- 1.9 The seller shall not be liable for any indirect or consequential loss howsoever sustained by a buyer.
- 1.10 As to clauses 1.4 and 1.5 and 1.8 time is of the essence.
- **1.11** The seller and the buyer may vary the provisions of clauses 1.4, 1.5, 1.8, 1.9 and/or 1.10 if but only if and insofar as the variation is set out in writing and signed by each of the parties and a copy sent to the Society.
- 1.12 The terms of any statutory enactment or custom or trade which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Guarantee are hereby excluded.
- 1.13 Failure to comply with any of this Guarantee will allow the Society, at its discretion, to cancel Society membership.
- 1.14 This Guarantee does not exempt a breeder from the Sale of Goods and Supply of Services Act 1980.

# CONDITIONS OF SALE BLESSINGTON PREMIER SHOW & SALE 2024

- Without prejudice to the foregoing rules it is hereby expressly declared that the seller by selling & the buyer by
  purchasing shall be bound by the rules notwithstanding the terms of any statutory enactment or custom or trade
  to the contrary.
- 2. The auctioneer is the judge of the sale to whom all disputes or differences of any kind which may arise at or in relation to the auction either between the seller and the buyer or amongst the bidders themselves shall be referred and his decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
- 3. Any disputes as to any matter of the settlement of which no provision was made in these rules shall be referred to an arbitrator to be appointed failing agreement between or amongst the parties by the auctioneers and the decision of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on all parties to the dispute. Any arbitrator under this clause shall be subject to the Arbitration Act for the time being in force.
- 4. The highest bidder to be the purchaser, subject to the rule 7, and if any dispute shall arise between two bidders, the lot in dispute to be put up again and re-sold or the auctioneers may declare the purchaser.
- Purchasers to give their name and place of abode and payment in full, immediately upon the fall of the hammer if required.

- **6.** All lots to be cleared away at the buyer's expense at the close of sale, to be risk of the purchaser from the time the lot is sold and to be taken with all faults and errors of description.
- Purchasers at this sale, not complying with the above conditions, will be subject, without further notice, to have their lots re-sold, either by public auction or by private contract. The deposit money will be forfeited and any deficiency, with all expenses attending such re-sale to be made good by the defaulters on demand.
- 8. Rams and ewes to be sold in euros plus 5% commission. No shearling ram or ram lamb to be sold for less than €500. Shearling ewe or ewe lamb €400. No bid under €10.
- 9. Any sheep having artificially blackened heads and/or legs will be disqualified.
- Any sheep found to have a positive blood test for prohibitive substances will be disqualified and dealt with by disciplinary committee.
- 11. All sheep will be sold in order in which they appear in the catalogue.
- **12.** A red dot must be clearly marked on the shoulder of all substitute sheep.
- 13. All lots are "on the market" from the first bid. When the auctioneer's hammer falls, the vendor may accept or refuse the final bid. A vendor must say "yes" or "no" to the final bid before leaving the ring. If the vendor does not respond on the fall of the hammer this will be regarded as a "yes" and that animal will be taken as sold. No change from this will be entertained.
- 14. 1.5% levy will be charged to all vendors by the Suffolk Sheep Society on all lots/sheep sold at this sale. Blessington Mart will make this deduction on the day.
- 15. Credit card facilities at Blessington Mart Domestic Irish Visa Debit Cards €10k limit
- **16.** Vendors charged full commission if animal is not sold having reached the reserve.

# **Conditions of Entry 2024**

All the sheep entered for show and sale must be the produce of registered flocks, the property of a member of the Suffolk Sheep Society. All entries must be ARR/ARR and eligible for export and all rams must be Sire Verified and Brucella Ovis Tested. Flock numbers, individual earmarks and numbers of any sires mentioned must be stated on the entry form. All single shearling ewes/rams must have been shorn in 2024. Breeders have the option to shear-out their lambs. Any sheep having artificially blackened heads or legs or bearing tar or pitch will be disqualified. Forensic tests will be carried out on hair samples from the head or leg from one sheep from every pen. If it is found that any form of artificial colouring has been used on any animal tested, then the vendor will be instructed to remove his entire consignment from the sale yard. Entry as per new BN criteria. 8 be the maximum entry rams by one breeder of which only 3 may be shearling rams with each breeder's entry of ram lambs to be sold in 2 ballots. Member who are not 3 years registered can only enter 2 rams or lamb rams. Maximum two entries per breeder in both the single shearling ewe and ewe lamb classes. If the sale is oversubscribed Council may take the decision to cut numbers. The Exhibitor must breed ewe and ram lambs. Substitutes may only be made within the categories they have been entered. Exhibitors are permitted to substitute one ram lamb if they have up to & including 4 ram lambs entered. 2 substitutes for 5 to 8 inclusive. 1 ewe in the singles classes provided full details have been lodged with the Branch Secretary SSS South of Ireland Branch before 12 noon on Tuesday 1st August. No substitute will be accepted or permitted after that time. Exhibitors may not parade more than 2 ram lamb in the single lamb class. The first four lambs in the Novice class may only parade in the Open Class. Novice Class Premier Show 2024; Any breeder or flock owned jointly or individually owned at present time or previously registered whom has never won 1st prize at National Championships or Premier Show/Sale are eligible to compete in the Novice class. A novice breeder may show 2 lambs in the Novice Class and may not show any lambs in the Open class except a lamb placed in the first four in the Novice class. Class winner of the Open Class (class 7) may not parade in the Group of Three (class 9). A lamb can only be shown in one class with the exception of the Group of Three. All sheep must be numbered clearly with red on the day prior to the sale. All substitute sheep marked with red dot and the breeding to be placed on the pen on official substitute cards which are available from the Secretary. All sheep to be inspected by Inspectors appointed by the Society. They must only approve sheep considered likely to produce lambs worthy of the breed. In particular they will look for correct tagging, confirmation and excessive black wool. All inspectors and stewards are entitled to carry out any actions to ensure the correct running of the inspections, show and sale and the decisions of inspectors and stewards shall be final and binding. A Veterinary Surgeon shall be appointed for the inspection of correct mouths and in the case of rams, testes. No tampering with or un-naturally adjusting the mouths or teeth of sheep is permitted. In the event that any sheep is suspected by the Inspectors or veterinary surgeons of being tampered with, or un-naturally altered, including, but not limited to, filing teeth: owner shall upon being so required by the stewards forthwith remove such sheep and all other sheep in the same consignment from the Society Sale and the sale ground and the matter shall be referred to the relevant Animal Health Authorities All sheep will be inspected as they enter the penning area on arrival. Any sheep rejected by the inspectors or Veterinary Surgeon shall not be eligible for registration in the Society's flock book or the issue of a pedigree export certificate. The decision of the Inspectors and Veterinary Surgeon shall be final and binding and they shall be absolved of any responsibility for any actions taken as a result of their advice. Inspection time will commence at 11.30am on Friday 2nd August and finish at 2.30pm sharp. Sheep will not be accepted for show or sale before or after that time. The sale will commence on Saturday 3rd August at 11.00am. Entries will not be accepted from members who have not paid the current year's subscription or have outstanding fees to the Society. Minimum weight of ram lambs offered for sale 75kgs. White coats have to be worn when showing.

Minimum selling price: Rams: €500, Ewes & Ewe Lambs €400

Females offered for sale must be sold if bidding reaches €750 When rams are unsold at €1500 or over the owner will be charged 5% commission before the animal can be removed from the mart. Any vendor indebted to the branch will not be allowed to enter sheep at any Society sales. Transgressions of any rule of the Society will be punishable by 2 years suspension from selling at any of the Society or affiliated sales subject to a hearing at South of Ireland Council level.



# FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL VENDORS AT SOCIETY SALES

To protect the integrity of the breed it is important that sheep presented at Society events represent the best the Suffolk can offer. With this in mind members' attention is drawn to the following:

- 1. ARTIFICIAL COLOURING No artificial colouring of hair on heads/legs, dressing, bleaching or chemical agent (except Department of Environment, Fisheries and Rural Affairs approved and recognised show dip and colourless oil on the head) shall be used on or applied to sheep entered in this show/sale. In the event that any sheep is found by the Inspectors or veterinary surgeons to have been artificially coloured, the owner shall upon being so required by the stewards forthwith remove such sheep and all other sheep in the same consignment from the Society Sale and the sale ground and the breeder will be banned from entry into any Society Sale or Society Show held during the next calendar year.
- 2. **HAIR SAMPLES** Hair samples will be taken from each pen. A number of these will be selected at random at a later date and tested under clinical conditions for non-approved artificial colouring. Where found, the breeder will be notified in writing of the findings and banned from entry into any Society Sale or Society Show held during the next calendar year.
- 3. **INCORRECT MOUTHS/TESTES** The veterinary surgeons will, without limitation, inspect for correct mouths and evidence of mouth tampering and, in the case of rams, testes. Any sheep which is not approved by the Inspectors and/or veterinary surgeons shall upon being so required by the stewards forthwith remove such sheep and shall not be entered at any other Society sale and cannot be registered with the Society. The decisions of the Inspectors and veterinary surgeons on all such matters are and shall be final and binding, and (in the absence of bad faith) without any responsibility or liability on their part.
